he soignée Inn by the Sea I on the Atlantic Ocean outside of Portland, Maine, has two personalities. It has the soul of a simple seaside hotel and the elements of a sophisticated boutique re-

This 57-room establishment always has been blessed with the coast's most valuable commodities: an oceanfront location and direct access to a sweeping sand beach. After a total overhaul, the Inn by the Sea has emerged luxurious and refined, with striking contemporary decor, award-winning gourmet cuisine, a fine spa and a bird sanctuary flourishing in gardens of flora, all native to Maine.

Although very upscale, the Inn by the Sea is unpretentious and understated, qualities that are typically

The fancy features go beyond the usual trappings. The hotel's admirable ecoconscious policy includes recycled water systems, solar panels, bio-fuel, ecoeducation for kids and a spa that has a gold-standard "green" certification. The hotel practices waste management, large and small. Here's a good one. The housekeeper provides little bags so that you can take home your bar of soap. It's worth it. The Inn's toiletries are from l'Occitane of France.

During summer, the Inn will be in high family gear. If your gang of youngsters has seen-it-all and done-itall, they can test some of the Inn's inventive programs: exploring the beach with a naturalist, making munchies with the chef, seaside yoga, visiting a butterfly colony and art classes.

Almost everything at the Inn by the Sea is inspired by

the sea, including the hotel's spa. Signature treatments include the sea wave massage with aromatic oils, the sea breeze facial, the deepsea soothing massage and the marine body polish with sea salts and hydrating creams.

The Inn's Sea Glass restaurant is more like a stylish bistro than a staid hotel dining room, and the cuisine matches. Seafood rules with creative dishes like seared scallops with fennel salad, pan-roasted cod, paella or roasted mussels. The chef's Garden Dinners, served on farm tables on the lawn on summertime Wednesdays, are a big reason to hope for good, hot weather. These are limited-edition feasts featuring local delicacies. Or you can go all-lobster, all the time, starting with a lobster omelette for breakfast, a lobster roll for lunch, and for dinner, butter-poached lobster with citrus and leek risotto.

Wow! Bow-wow! Pooches have major privileges at Inn by the Sea, which organizes leisurely Dog Days with spa services and doggie daycare.

Among the free perks for every canine guest are porcelain bowls, beach towels, treats and fluffy dog blankets by L.L. Bean, the famous outfitter based in Maine.

Perhaps the biggest concession to dogs at the Inn by the Sea is that they are welcome in the hotel's lounge and on the terrace while their owners are having drinks or supper. Dogs are so prized here that they have their own bar menu with nibblies like Angus beef tips, homemade biscuits and meat "roaff."

Dog Days features in-room massages and Happy Hour on the lawn on Tuesdays during summer.

Doggie guests can lap up K-9 ice cream – at no charge - and when owners buy a signature cocktail, the Inn donates \$1 for an animal rescue organization.

In autumn, the Inn's swimming pool goes to the dogs literally. During the last two weeks of October the pool is closed to people and open for pets to enjoy after a hot and sandy romp on the beach.

Dog guests also have their own books with titles like 101 Salivations and Bitchin' Beaches.
