Hostelling International has opened a 480-room establishment ideal for anyone who wants to bed down in a clean, safe, eco-conscious environment with a lot of extras: camaraderie, progressive functional design, communal activities and an international vibe. And all at amazing prices.

The Boston Hostel has three sleeping arrangements. Dorms have either four or eight bunks, and each dorm has its own bathroom in the hallway, so you are sharing with your roommates. Dorms are available in configurations for male, female and coed clientele. The hostel also has 20 private rooms, suitable for up to three people; each has an ensuite bathroom with a tiny sink and a shower. In the private spaces, there is the bonus of a flat-screen television with DirecTV service.

Dorm guests have their own so-called Custom Bed Oasis — that's the bunk bed with a good reading light, multiple electrical outlets, an individual locker and a safe for valuables. The ironing boards are handy if you have been backpacking and now have an appointment to meet the parents or the boss.

Linens and towels are supplied; for hygienic reasons, the hostel requests that you don't use your own sleeping bag, which might have been in one too many public

The hostel is brimming with energy on all fronts. Travellers from as many as 70 countries come through the lobby. Young and old, they can be seen draped over leather sofas, deep in conversation or

madly texting. The industrial design gives the place a high-tech feeling throughout, with white-painted brick walls. stairways of steel and oak, and exposed pipes. The cafe-

They might include bowling; a walk along the historic Freedom Trail; a TGIF pub crawl (for ages 21 and over); a trolley tour of major Boston sights; boat tours along the Charles River; and visits to Fenway Park, the beloved home of the Boston Red Sox. There are tours of Harvard on April 19, May 3 and May 10.

A cafeteria-style continental breakfast of pastries and yogurt is included in your stay, with eco-friendly appliances, and tea and coffee are available all day.
