Posh Naples hotel adds chic touches

There is big news at the petite, posh Inn on Fifth in Naples, Fla.

This city of about 20,000 on the Gulf of Mexico is known for its elegant Mediterranean-style architecture and quiet, palm-lined streets. It's a more tony and reserved enclave than the busy, brash Atlantic coast and the Inn on Fifth reflects that upscale ambience.

The hotel is a boutique beauty, the centrepiece of "downtown," on fashionable Fifth Avenue South. It is so prominent in Naples that, as a guest. I felt like visiting royalty. Everywhere I went, locals would ask where I was staying and the reaction always was a swoon: "Oooh, the Inn on Fifth!"

The bulletin for 2014 encompasses two openings: Avenue5, a stylish bistro (that uses stylish typography) specializing in Atlantic lobster; and the Club Level Suites, an exclusive annex of 32 superlative accommodations.

New annex is tops

The Inn on Fifth is a Tuscan-looking villa in butteryellow stucco, with handquarried stone inlays, terra cotta tiling and wrought-iron balconies.

The main building houses the plush Spa on Fifth, plus 87 recently-renovated rooms and suites featuring classiccontemporary decor, handsome dark furniture and glamorous chandeliers. All the rooms have plush pillowtop bedding and balconies with views of palm trees waving in the breeze and a symphony of mockingbirds, sparrows and robins.

The rooftop swimming pool is surrounded by a colourful Floridian garden of miniature palms, ferns and tropicand sunny yellow. If you love pool life, 10 guest rooms open directly onto the deck; the others are more secluded.

The Club Level takes the deluxe Inn on Fifth to a new

level. Here, the keyword "new" means the finest combed-cotton sheets and luxuriousbathrobestrimmed with satin. The latest technical and hardware essentials include motion-sensor lighting, movie channels, iPod docks and white marble bathrooms with TVs, telephones and rain showers.

But, the lounge! If you are springing for a Club Level visit, you will revel in considerable perks: an excellent continental breakfast, all-day snacks, evening canapés such as Gulf shrimp and an open bar, including spirits and Champagne. Guests also have an around-town shuttle - a choice of a Cadillac Escalade or golf carts -- for shopping, gallery-hopping or the beach, which is two kilometres away.

Drinks and dinner

Avenue5 (new name, progressive typography) is a flashy street-level bistro with streamlined white and glass decor and splashes of orange, silver and ebony. Connoisseurs can choose from a fishery delivering delicacies al flowers blooming in scarlet towering, two-storey wall of daily. Florida's stone crab wine. Mixologists reign in an island bar, creating cocktails infused with herbs.

Avenue5 serves something delectable all the time. For lunch: turkey burgers, duck are half-price.

flatbread, vichyssoise and papaya or Cobb salads. For dinner: Maine lobster, oysters Rockefeller, Florida grouper, a gourmet burger with the works, plus meat and fish from the grill. And for Sunday Brunch: crab cakes benedict and bottomless mimosas.

Adjacent to the hotel is Truluck's Seafood, Steak and Crab House, a classic of Naples which has its own season runs Oct. 15 to May 15 and Truluck's runs an allyou-can-eat special on Monday nights. At cocktail hour, drinks and the supper menu

Fifth Avenue's calendar includes an exuberant Halloween celebration with music, kids' animation and a costume party (Oct.31); the Santa Claus Parade (Dec.9); the Downtown Naples New Year's Art Fair (Jan. 3-4); the Ferrari Club (Feb. 15-16); and the St. Patrick's Day Parade (March 14).

The inn also is within The anti-aging Miracle a block of Naples Trol-Facial works with Israeli ley Tours, which tootles around to local highlights, including the Naples Museum of Art, and shopping at Waterside and Third Street South.
