San Diego's SeaWorld offers discount for Canadian residents

The huge marine park SeaWorld San Diego in Southern California is offering a 40-per-cent discount on admission for Canadian residents.

This brings the price to US\$52 (down from US\$83-\$89) for adults and children ages three to nine. There is no admission charge for children under three.

The Canadian Residence Offer is valid until Dec. 3, only on tickets purchased online at SeaWorld-SanDiego.com.

tion: Nov. 19-Jan.1, will feature the park's famous Shamu in a special nighttime killer whale show, Shamu Christmas Miracles, plus Santa Claus, live reindeer and more of SeaWorld's holiday shows, including Pets Rule Christmas, starring shelter-adopted cats and dogs; Dolphin Island Christmas; and Clyde & Seamore's Christmas Special starring sea lions.

The aquariums at SeaWorld feature nearly 13,000 fish and invertebrates of more than 500 species, including piranhas and leopard sharks.
