Kennebunkport is a 5½-hour drive from Montreal. Take Highway 10 east to Exit 22 and Routes 35 and 133 south to the U.S. border. Take Interstates 89 and 93 south through Vermont and New Hampshire. In Maine, take Route 101 east to Highway 95 north.

Breakwater Inn & Spa: 127-133 Ocean Ave., Kennebunkport, Me., 207-967 5333, www.thebreakwaterinn.com. Prices include full continental breakfast buffet, afternoon tea, use of spa (steam room, rain showers), LifeCycle fitness room, bicycles and canoes. Weekday rates are \$179 to \$319 U.S. in rooms or junior suites for two, per night; suites are \$419; Waterfront cottage is \$519 per night. Rates are higher on weekends.

The Pamper Me Package starts at \$562 for two and includes a \$200 spa voucher per person. The Trio Package, starting at \$569 for two, includes dinner and a \$150 spa credit per person. Prices will decrease around mid-October.
