Saguenay (including the merged communities of Chicoutimi, Jonquière and La Baie) is about a six-hour drive from Montreal. Take Highway 40 to Quebec City, continue on Routes 73 north, 175 north and 170 east.

Saguenay-en-Bouffe: Oct. 14 to 24, 800-463-6565, www.saguenayenbouffe.com. International dinners, \$27.95 per person.

Hôtellerie Cepal Villégiature: 3350 St. Dominique St., Saguenay (Jonquière sector), 800-361-5728, www.cepalaventure.com. Prices include use of three-kilometre hiking trail, tennis courts, mountain bike trail. From Sunday to Thursday: \$72 for a standard room with a king-sized bed to \$132 for a suite with a whirlpool tub, for two without meals; or \$162 to \$234 for two people with breakfast and dinner. On Friday and Saturday, it's \$92 to \$152 for two without meals, or \$182 to \$252 for two people with breakfast and dinner. Lunch is available. A two-bedroom chalet is available. Prices are slightly lower from Oct. 15 to May 1. In summer, there is an outdoor pool, sailing, canoeing and kayaking program (www.kayaksaguenay.com).
