Rooms and suites cost \$195 to \$275 U.S. for two people, per night, including breakfast; cottages for two people cost \$295 to \$315; additional children or adults, \$30. Holiday rates (Dec 19-Jan. 1) are higher. There can be a two-night minimum for Saturday visits and a three-night minimum on holidays.

Dinner is served at 7 p.m. Wednesday to Sunday; costs \$38 for inn guests and \$40 (\$45 on Saturdays) for non-guests.
